



Caring for Your Harlequin Floor

Harlequin Vinyl Performance Surfaces

(Does not apply to Harlequin Hi-Shine™; see reverse for Hi-Shine care)

Daily Maintenance

- 1. Sweep or vacuum the entire area to remove all loose dirt, dust and other foreign matter.
- 2. Mop the floor with a solution of lukewarm water and **Harlequin Daily Cleaner** (4 ounces of cleaner per gallon of water)
- 3. Rinse the floor thoroughly with lukewarm water and wet-vac the entire surface to remove all excess water.
- 4. Allow the floor to dry completely.

For Heavy Use - Bi-Monthly Maintenance

- 1. Vacuum the entire floor surface with a heavy-duty commercial vacuum to remove all loose dirt, dust and other foreign matter.
- 2. Mix a solution of lukewarm water and Harlequin Heavy Duty Cleaner (2 ounces of cleaner per gallon of water)
- 3. Scrub the surface with an automatic scrubbing machine such the Harlequin Micro-Mini Scrubber (150-350 rpm).
- 4. Rinse floor thoroughly with lukewarm water and wet-vac the entire surface to remove all excess water.
- 5. Allow the floor to dry completely.

Remember...

- Dust, dirt and spills should always be removed promptly.
- Stubborn scuff marks can be removed with Harlequin Heavy Duty Cleaner.
- Do not apply any type of floor sealer, finish, or wax.
- Do not sweep or mop the floor with oil treated mops or brooms.
- Do not scrub the floor with hard polyester or nylon pads, steel wool, wire brushes, or abrasive floor cleaners.
- · Avoid outdoor shoes on your Harlequin floor. If they must be worn, ensure they are wiped before stepping on the floor.

Daily Maintenance

- 1. Follow a regular maintenance schedule of sweeping or vacuuming to remove dirt, debris or dust that could scratch or be ground into the surface of the floor.
- 2. Floors should be damp wiped with Bona® Hardwood Cleaner on a regular basis to remove dirt and debris from the surface of the floor.

Remember

- · Wipe up spills immediately.
- · Do not apply wax or use oil treated dust mops.
- Never clean with a steam mop, water, or use a cleaner that is mixed with water.
- When moving heavy equipment or appliances put a large heavy blanket underneath them to avoid scratches and dents.

Harlequin Hi-Shine™

Harlequin Hi-Shine is produced from specially formulated PVC with a unique high-gloss finish. With proper care this floor can be used again and again.

Daily Maintenance

- Sweep the floor with a soft broom or dust mop to remove any loose dirt, debris, and dust.
- 2. Any marks on the floor can be removed by lightly spraying an all-purpose cleaner (Johnson Fantastik® recommended) and wiping with a clean, dry cloth or dust mop (Swiffer® sweeper recommended). If tougher marks remain isopropyl alcohol can be used.

Tape

- Harlequin Double-Sided Tape is recommended when taping the underside of the floor to a sub-floor. The high-tack/low-tack tape is a safe and secure option for working with temporary applications.
- · Carefully remove tape by gently pulling up and working parallel to the floor.
- Top-taping of Hi-Shine is not recommended because removal of the tape could damage the floor.

Remember...

- Do not use abrasive powders or creams, strong solvents such as acetone, bleach, ammonia or highly alkaline solutions. They will result in irreversible damage.
- Do not use Goof Off or Goo Gone.
